STEP 1: Download the Roku Smart Home app

STEP 2: Install your doorbell & chime

What's that light mean?

Doorbell	State
WHITE - Solid	Charging
BLUE - Solid	Fully charged

Chime	State
RED - Flashing	Connecting to doorbell
YELLOW - Flashing	Waiting for connections
BLUE - Flashing	Connecting to network
BLUE - Solid	Connected
